Directions

All Town Hall Lectures will be held at the Morris Lawrence Building (MLB) on the Washtenaw Community College campus.

The WCC entrance closest to MLB is off Huron River Drive, opposite Emergency Drive, just north of Clark Road. The WCC entrance off Clark Road is closest to the Parking Structure.

From Ann Arbor (Downtown):

Take Huron Street east to Washtenaw Avenue

Turn left on Hogback Road (Carpenter Road intersection)

Turn right (next light) on Clark Road

Turn left (second light) on Huron River Drive (Golfside intersection)

Turn left at first Washtenaw Committee College entrance (opposite big red Emergency sign)

The Morris Lawrence Building straight ahead

Parking

WCC Lot 1 (see map) in front of MLB offers the shortest walk. **WCC Lot 2** and **Parking Structure (PS)** are also options.

Accessible parking is available in all 3 locations.

Transportation

AAATA GoldRide Senior Card

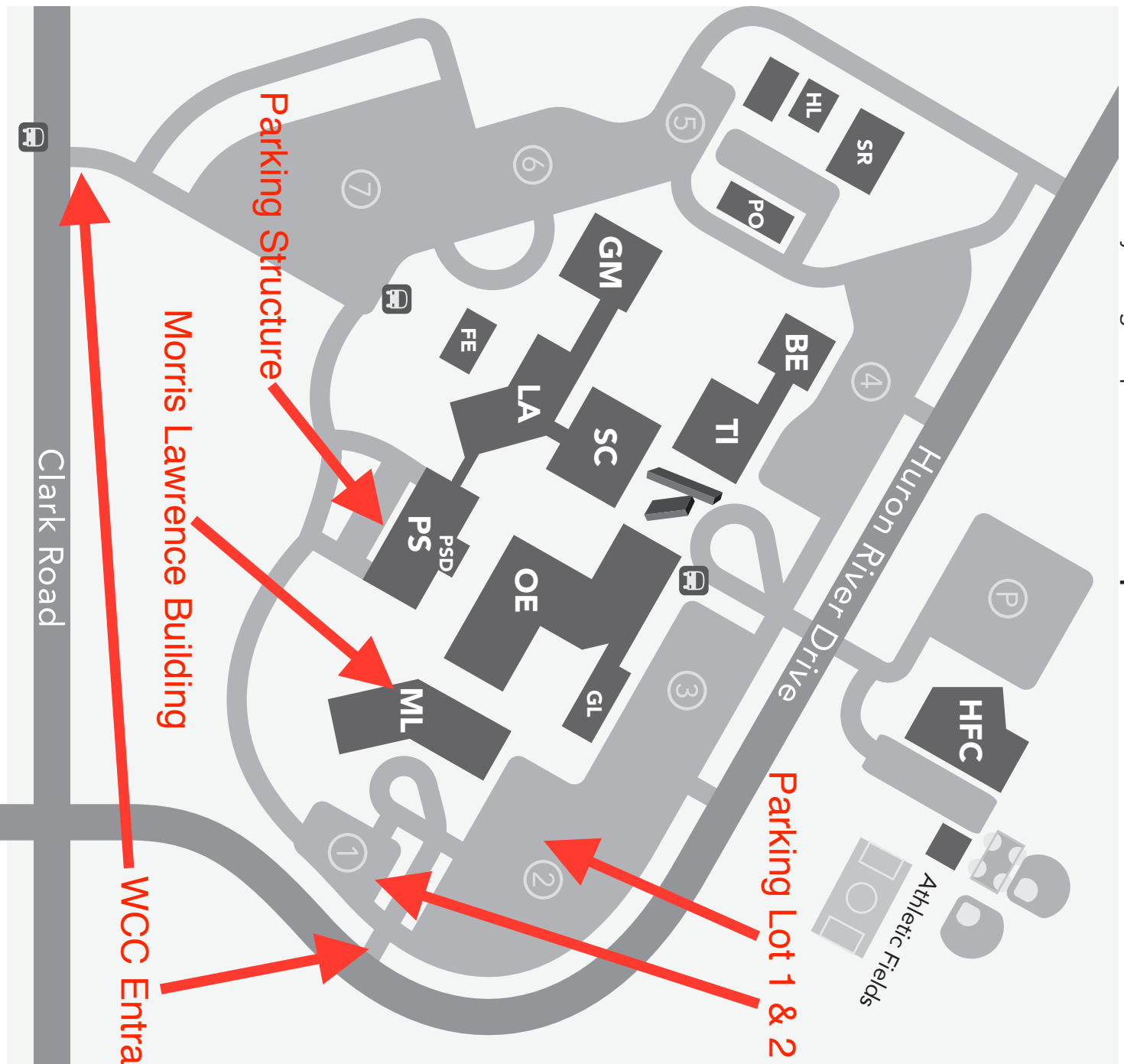
If you are 65 or older, you may obtain a FREE “GoldRide Senior Card” at AAATA’s main office (2700 S. Industrial). Bring a valid ID, such as, a driver’s license, State ID or Passport. The GoldRide ID card allows eligible seniors to travel FREE on any AAATA regular line bus service, and offers share-ride service around the city and to Washtenaw Community College.


How you can get to the Waterman Lectures:

By Bus – Only Bus #3 from both Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti and Bus #24 from Ann Arbor will take you to and from Washtenaw Community College.

By Share-Ride Service – If you live within the Ann Arbor City Limits, you may travel to and from Washtenaw Community College (drop-off/pickup point: Student Center). To reserve a share-ride trip 1-7 days in advance, call (734) 973 1611 (select option 2). No same day service is available. The cost is \$3.00 each direction. Your ride will arrive within a 30-minute window of the scheduled pick-up time. Also, consider that the Waterman Town Hall Q & A may not end until around 1:15 p.m.
